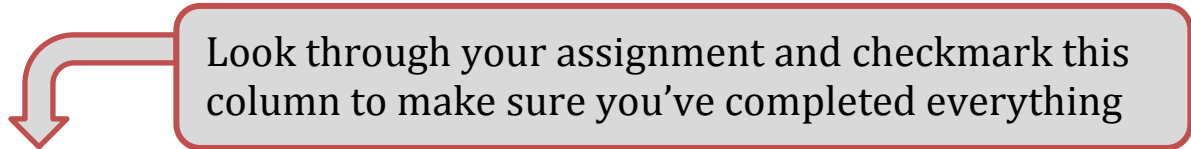


Comparing Prices Marking Checklist
